

Active Shooter Workshop Rochester, NY – 14 May

Overview: Preparing employees for a potential active shooter event is an integral component of an organization's incident response planning. Because active shooter incidents are unpredictable and evolve quickly, preparing for and knowing what to do in an active shooter situation can be the difference between life and death. Every second counts.

This workshop will go into greater detail than the 2-hour monthly active shooter webinar that CISA offers. Attendees will leave with a running start on developing an active shooter preparedness program for their own organization.

Objectives:

- Provide information about best practices, communications protocols, and resources that will assist stakeholders to develop or enhance their emergency planning, preparedness, and response to active shooter incidents.
- Discuss the elements of active shooter incident response planning with guidance from expert instructors.
- Describe common behaviors, conditions, and situations associated with active shooter events.
- Discuss how to recognize potential workplace violence indicators.
